[‡]Benign imaging features: homogeneous, low attenuation (<20 HU), no enhancement, smooth margins. §Evaluate: PET vs. MRI vs. biopsy. ||Suspicious imaging features: heterogeneous, enhancement, irregular margins, necrosis, splenic parenchymal or vascular invasion, substantial enlargement. ¶Indeterminate imaging features: heterogeneous, intermediate attenuation (>20 HU), enhancement, smooth margins. *Follow-up MRI in 6 and 12 months.
