(2) Explainable disease such as autoimmune disease, prior radiation therapy, prior infection, history of renal disease, medications. (3) For unexplained causes, consider pericarditis (acute/constrictive and infection), post-myocardial infarction, undiagnosed disease such as metabolic (hypothyroidism, uremic), autoimmune, sarcoidosis.
